The 2018 BART prom theme is "Red Carpet." Prom is open to all BART high school students and will be held on Saturday, May 19, at The Williams Inn (1090 Main St, Williamstown) from 7 to 10:30 p.m. Everyone is encouraged to arrive early for outside photos with peers and parents. Tickets cost \$30 for a single, and \$50 for a pair of tickets. All tickets must be purchased in advance. Tickets will NOT be available for purchase at the prom. A pasta dinner with dessert will be included in the event. Tickets go on sale the week of May 7 and can be purchased either during lunches or from Ms. Calderara. Attending students are allowed to bring one outside guest. All guests must be in high school and have a completed Guest Permission Form (available when buying tickets).

# **Events**

- MASS MoCA Teen Invitational. An annual event celebrating artwork from our area's schools, the <u>Teen Invitational at MASS MoCA</u> will once again include selected artworks by BART students. There is no charge to attend tonight's opening reception at 7 p.m. Presentation of awards will begin at 7:30 p.m., to be followed by live music. Those who plan to attend can look forward to huge crowds and a great party! The exhibition will also be on view May 12 and 13 from 11 a.m. to 5 p.m. General museum admission fees will apply at that time.
- Annual Eighth Grade Banquet. Mark your calendar if you have a student in the eighth grade! The Eighth Grade Banquet will be held at the school next week on Monday, May 14, from 6 to 7:30 p.m. This annual event recognizes and celebrates the accomplishments of the grade 8 class and is free of charge to attend. Every grade 8 student is allowed to bring up to 2 guests. More information will be made available closer to the event.
- **Musical Performances.** The BART Theatre Department will be presenting *The Addams Family,* a musical comedy showcasing the students from Ms. Trainor's Musical Theatre production class. Directed by Ms. Trainor, with musical direction by Mr. Bergin and choreography by Natalie Celebi (Class of 2019), performances will be at the school on Friday, May 25, and Saturday, May 26, at 7:30 p.m. Tickets are \$10 for adults, \$7 for seniors and students, and \$3 for BART students.

- SLCs and Portfolio Presentations. With the end of the school year approaching, advisors will soon be contacting parents to schedule either a Student-Led Conference or a Portfolio Presentation. As a reminder, Portfolio Presentations happen in gateway grades 8, 11 and 12. SLCs happen in all other grades. Presentations showcase accomplishments and reflection on student learning and growth. We look forward to seeing you!
- Local History Showcase. Begining last quarter, Mrs. Calderara's tenth grade American History class took on a sizeable research project on Berkshire County. Students chose a building or plot of land to research as far back as possible using various tools: the internet, local libraries, town or city halls, Registry of Deeds of central and northern Berkshire county, conversations with local historians, or interviews with people connected to the project's building or land. Students will present their final projects (a five-page research paper and a creative project) at a Local History Showcase open to family and friends to attend. The showcase will be held at the school from 4 to 6 p.m. on Thursday, May 31. We hope everyone will join us and take advantage of this opportunity to learn more about our area.
