***Boston Business Journal Cites BART Among Top-Performing Schools in the State***

Berkshire Arts and Technology Charter Public School (BART) was ranked the #5 top-performing high school by the Boston Business Journal. BART is the only school on the list to represent Berkshire County in an article by Eric Convey titled "MCAS 2015: The top-performing high schools in Massachusetts". The Boston Business Journal examined the performance in English language arts, math, and science MCAS scores to rank public high schools in the state for the 2014-2015 academic year.

BART was ranked #2 in the state for 10<sup>th</sup> grade MCAS performance in math and #3 in the state for 10<sup>th</sup> grade MCAS performance in English language arts. Finally, BART was ranked #13 in the state for 10<sup>th</sup> grade MCAS performance in science.
