Dear Parents of High School Students,

We are proud to announce that we will continue to allow qualifying high school students to seek off-campus lunch alternatives within walking distance to the school. In order to qualify, a student must earn this privilege by being in "good standing." A student in "good standing" as defined as:

- **Passing all classes (equal to or greater than 70%)**
- **92.5% Attendance Record**
- **No discipline referrals within one month, suspensions within three months**

Students who qualify to participate in this program have the option to leave campus for high school lunch. During their time off-campus, students will be responsible for their own behavior and will not be supervised by school personnel. As representatives of the school, they will be expected to meet and exceed all of the rules in the Whatever It Takes contract.

The off-campus lunch program was originally enacted by the BART student council. The following regulations update the language of that resolution to reflect BART's current situation.

- Off-campus lunch is a privilege extended to high school students in good standing. It offers those students the chance to walk to local Adams lunch providers within the established lunch period one day a week, as decided by administration and grade level teams.
- In order to qualify for off-campus lunch privileges students must be in high school, be passing all classes, have a 92.5% attendance record, and have received no discipline referrals within one month (no suspensions within three months).
- Students opting for the off-campus lunch option are responsible for obtaining written parent permission on the correct form (see reverse). Permission will be kept on file in BART administrative offices.
- Students participating in off-campus lunch will walk to a local restaurant. No car travel is permitted. Students are not permitted to travel in their own cars or give rides to others during this time.
- A sign out sheet shall be used by all students to indicating their destination.
- Students must return from off-campus lunch within the established lunch time or risk loss of privileges and/or disciplinary action.
- Students need to keep in mind that they are representing BART in the community and must adhere to BART's Code of Conduct at all times.
- Students are encouraged to seek and find healthy lunches at local food establishments.
