BART Enrollment Lottery to be Held at 5pm on June 6, 2011

BART Charter Public School will hold a lottery on Monday, June 6th at 5pm to determine the order of students on the waitlist for the 6th and 9th grades for the 2011-2012 school year. Applicants who applied by the May 27th deadline will be entered into this lottery and are welcome to attend. Waitlisted students will be enrolled at the school as space becomes available.

BART's next enrollment deadline is Monday, June 27th at 12pm. 10 seats are available in 7th grade and 6 seats are available in 8th grade for the 2011-2012 school year. Students still interested in 6th and 9th grades are encouraged to apply. (No students will be accepted into grades 10, 11 or 12.) A lottery will be held on June 27th at 4:00pm in the school's atrium for new applicants to 6th and 9th grade and, if more students apply than spaces available, for grades 7 and 8.

Transportation is available for students in Adams, Cheshire, Clarksburg, Florida, Hancock, Lanesborough, North Adams, Pittsfield, Savoy and Williamstown.
